

Type of Wine: Red Wine

Appellation of Origin: DOC Rioja **Winery:** Labastida, Rioja Alavesa

Varietal: 100% Tempranillo. Vines are between 40-80 years old. **Terrain:** Labastida, in the Rioja Alavesa, can be found at the highest, most northern edge of Rioja, were climactic conditions are nearly ideal for wine production. The soil is a mixture of clay and limestone, and is made up of mostly southwest facing terraces. Average rainfall is slightly over 15 inches per year. **Harvest:** Hand picked and selected twice: initially in the vineyard, with a second selection on receipt at the winery.

Bottling: Bottled on the property.

Serving Temperature: Between 61° and 65° F

Alcohol Content: 13%
